- Graphite Drawing Pencils 6B, 4B, 2B, B, 2H 4H, 6H (Usually comes in a set)
- Compressed Charcoal (soft and hard)
- Set of Oil or Chalk pastels – student preference
- Black Drawing Ink (india ink)
- Elmers Adhesive glue sticks 3 (for collage) or comparable brand
- Ink Pen Introductory set
- Acrylic Paint Set – Black, White, Red, Blue, Yellow, Green Students may purchase other colors but can also mix colors
- Palette Knife – can be plastic or metal
- Disposable palette paper (get a packet or freezer paper also works)
- Sketchbook – 11 x 14
- Newsprint Pad 18 x 24”
- Kneaded Eraser
- Gum eraser
- Scissors
